# Greetings to all.....

Artificial Intelligence (AI) simulates human learning, comprehension, problem solving, decision-making, creativity and autonomy with the aid of machine and computers. The concept of AI usage dates back to the 1950's, when machines were designed to exhibit human intelligence. In 1980's,

technologies were developed that enabled AI systems to learn from historical data. Deep learning gained momentum in 2010, relying on machine learning models designed to mimic the function of human brain. Since 2020, Gen AI gained traction utilizing deep learning models to create original content. Agriculture in recent time faced a multitude of challenges including climate change, acute scarcity of skilled human labor, ecological imbalance, high cost of external inputs, etc., Adopting innovative practices and leveraging technological advancements to enhance the productivity of existing resources has become crucial to meet the growing demand for agricultural and allied products from the expanding population. One such innovative practice is adoption of AI driven technologies in agriculture. AI has got numerous applications in the field of agriculture. Al driven predictive analytics enables farmers to forecast future yields based on historical data and weather patterns, remote sensing techniques, hyper-spectral imaging and AI enable crop health monitoring, deploying of sensor based automated irrigation system combats inefficient water use. AI technologies prepare farmers to handle crisis and uncertainty efficiently and AI based market analytics helps them to market their produce efficiently. In addition, AI based technologies have significant potential to attract tech-savvy youth reducing drudgery in agriculture AI ultimately fosters sustainability by encouraging precision farming, imparts resilience by preparing farmers for uncertain events and enhances environmental stewardship. Our university is in the forefront in imparting education on use of AI technologies in agriculture and allied sciences for graduating students by including it in the course curricula and by offering pilot courses on AI and machine learning and creating awareness among farmers about the benefit of AI through capacity building programmes through RAWEP and extension wing. On research front, university has initiated pilot project to evaluate the effectiveness of AI driven drone technologies in monitoring and managing crop health, irrigation fertigation mapping of watershed areas for management of natural resources. The University also provides technical advice and necessary infrastructure to the aspiring graduates interested in establishing startups related to AI technologies with implications in agriculture sector. AI is not a substitute or replacement for human resource rather, it should complement human efforts in achieving sustainable

An International Apitherapy workshop and honey festival was jointly organized by Garden City University, KSNUAHS, Shivamogga and UAS, Bengaluru from 25-11-2024 to 29-11-2024. The workshop aimed at dissemination of information on the potent properties of honey, royal jelly, propolis, bee venom and bee pollen that promote physical well-being and address various health concerns. The workshop served to highlight the intricate relationship between humans and bees in the pursuit of



optimal health. The inaugural session and first two days' activities of the workshop was held at Garden City University. The inaugural speech was delivered by Dr. G. M. Devagiri, Dean (Forestry).
